About Programme:

As of 30 April 2024, approximately 2,100 displaced persons from Ukraine are living in Japan, with more than 70% of whom are women, mainly in their 20s to 40s. As their stay in Japan is prolonged, the Government of Japan has adopted the measure of "Support for Persons Subject to Complementary Protection" to ensure the protection of conflict-displaced persons, thereby creating an environment in which displaced persons from Ukraine can live in Japan as 'long term residents (five years)'.

This "Entrepreneurship Development Training for Ukrainian Women and Youth in Japan" aims to support Ukrainian people living in Japan particularly with evacuees and university students to become self-reliant by providing them with opportunities to learn entrepreneurship and relevant skills, enabling to generate entrepreneurial ideas and business planning for new business creation and job finding in Japan, with a view to enriching Ukrainian communities in Japan as well as giving back to Ukraine.

37 participants were selected this time to participate in 1st edition of the programme from June 10-14 2024, organized by UNIDO ITPO Tokyo in cooperation with the Investment and Technology Office in Bahrain (UNIDO ITPO Bahrain). https://www.unido.or.jp/en/coming/12045/
